At the same time, you as a congregation stepped in and saw that all was taken care of. Your support and caring were overwhelming. You continue to be there for me to help with whatever I need during worship.

THANKOFFERING SERVICE

On Sunday, May 6th, the celebration of Thankoffering will be part of our service. Thankoffering is a part of the stewardship of the Women of the ELCA. Below is a history of the

long standing tradition which shows the powerful impact women can have on the church. Women of the ELCA and its predecessors were ahead of the times.

As we collect the Thankoffering today, we share in a tradition dating back to the 1800s, when Christian women formed "mite" or "cent" societies to support local and international missions. When others in the church said there was not enough money to carry out these projects, the women believed otherwise. Each woman collected offerings at home until the community of women gathered with thanks and praise to combine their offerings and offer them up to the mission. When Women of the ELCA formed more than 25 years ago, we committed to continue this tradition of giving in gratitude for blessings. Each year, in thousands of congregations, Thankofferings are collected to support the lifechanging ministries of the churchwide women's organization.


