Treasurer Report – April 2023

We had a fabulous month of income for April of approximately \$7,000, which brings our net income for the year to \$11,000. This year has been off to a great start!!!!

Some notable activity for the month is the following: Monthly offerings were approximately \$14,600.

We had income of \$2,180 from fundraising, (Soup Sales - \$935 and Bingo \$1,245)

We also had unrealized gains on our investments of \$1,400.

Expenses were relatively low compared to prior months. Some notable expense activity includes:

\$335 for organ maintenance

\$500 for Easter Flowers

\$300 for janitorial supplies

\$700 for maintenance and repairs for heating system

At the end of April, we had \$9,000 in checking account. Our savings account has a balance of \$24,200.

FOOD BANK

We support the Northampton Food Bank. We do this by monetary gifts but also by donating non perishable food and can goods. This year we have not done a great job of giving can goods. There is a need for food items, there are many that rely on the food bank to keep their family fed. We never know how the economy is going to go. **Please help by bringing food items to the church.**


